- The potential impact of this residency in furthering the career of the artist.
- The proposed community engagement project.

1. Goal for the residency (Max 250 words)

Describe your intent and goals for the duration of the residency including work processes, materials and/or equipment you will be working with during your residency. Please ensure to include how this particular residency will impact you, and why you wish to do this residency here in the Village of Chester.

2. Documentation of Artistic Work

Please provide 5-10 images saved as .jpg files. Each image should have a number with your name and image title to insure they are presented in the orderyou wish. Provide a numbered image list (artist, title, medium, dimensions/duration and date).

3. Community Engagement Proposal (max 150 words)

Please provide us with a brief overview of the community engagement you wish to do during the residency. This could be a short workshop, a demonstration, an interactive artist talk, a combination, or something else all together. If you are accepted into the residency we will work with you to refine your idea if needed. Your planned project should only take approximately 1-4 hours of your time to present.
